PAYMENTS:

The 35th District Court will gladly accept and encourages payments on balances of disposed cases on civil and criminal files. Your payment will be credited to your balance and you will receive a receipt.

WARRANTS:

If the case/file is in warrant status and has been disposed, the Defendant may make payments but the case will remain in warrant status until paid in full or they appear before the Judge. If the case is not yet disposed of, the Defendant will have to appear before the Judge. Failure to make timely payments pursuant to an installment payment plan will result in the issuance of a bench warrant.

PROBATION VIOLATIONS:

If the probation violation notice has been sent, payments will be accepted by cash or money order (**no checks accepted**) and credited to your balance. However, the Defendant still has to appear before the judge if it is not a money issue only or the probation officer withdraws the violation.

DRIVER LICENSE SUSPENSION:

Absent a Judge's order, the final \$45.00 owed on any moving violation is the clearance fee paid to the Secretary of State. Until that fee is paid, you will not receive a clearance to lift that suspension.
